1. Introduction

Cavernoma Ireland is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store and protect personal data when you visit our website:

Cavernoma Ireland is the Data Controller and processes personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Ireland's Data Protection Act 2018.

2. What Information We Collect

A. Information You Provide Voluntarily

We only collect personal information when you submit it through our Contact Form.

This includes:

- Your name
- Your email address
- The message or information you choose to send us

We do not operate user accounts, online sales, or membership logins on our website.



B. Information Collected Automatically

When you visit our website, certain technical information may be collected automatically, including:

- IP address
- Browser type and version
- Operating system
- Pages visited
- Time and date of visit
- Referring website

This information is used for security, website performance and statistical analysis purposes.

3. How We Use Your Information

We use the information you provide only to:

- Respond to your enquiry
- Provide information you have requested
- Maintain website security
- Monitor and improve website performance

We do not:

- Sell your data
- Share your data for marketing purposes
- Use your data for profiling
- Send unsolicited marketing emails

We will only contact you in relation to the query you submitted.

4. Legal Basis for Processing

Under GDPR, we rely on the following legal bases:

- **Consent** - when you submit information through our contact form
- **Legitimate Interest** - to ensure website security and improve functionality
- **Legal Obligation** - where required under Irish law



5. Website Hosting - Wix.com

Our website is hosted on the Wix.com platform.

Wix.com provides the online infrastructure that enables us to operate our website. Your data may be stored through:

- Wix.com data storage
- Wix databases
- Wix applications

Wix stores data on secure servers behind a firewall and acts as a Data Processor on our behalf.

6. Cookies

Essential Cookies

Our website uses an essential session cookie known as a client-session binding cookie.

This cookie:

- Is required for security and API protection
- Is essential for website functionality
- Does not identify you personally
- Expires when you close your browser

Because this cookie is strictly necessary for the operation of the website, it does not require consent.

Analytics Cookies

We use:

- Google Analytics
- Wix Analytics

These tools collect anonymous or aggregated information such as:

- Number of visitors
- Pages visited
- Time spent on pages
- General geographic region
- Referral sources



This data helps us improve website performance and understand visitor engagement.

We do not use:

- Marketing cookies
- Advertising cookies
- Tracking for commercial purposes

7. Data Sharing

We do not sell or rent personal data.

We may share data only with:

- Wix.com (website hosting provider)
- Google Analytics (website analytics provider)
- Legal or regulatory authorities where required by law

All processors are required to maintain appropriate security and confidentiality safeguards.

8. Data Retention

We retain personal data:

- For as long as necessary to respond to your enquiry
- For a reasonable administrative period thereafter
- In accordance with legal or regulatory requirements

We do not retain personal data longer than necessary.

9. Data Security

We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data, including:

- Secure website hosting via Wix
- Password-protected administrative access
- Secure email access
- Restricted access to authorised Management Committee members only

10. Your Rights Under GDPR

You have the right to:

- Access your personal data
- Request correction of inaccurate data
- Request erasure (“right to be forgotten”)
- Restrict processing
- Object to processing
- Request data portability
- Withdraw consent at any time
